

160/500 TUNING DIAL SLIPPAGE

There are two pinch clutches (see photo of bottom side of chassis) that need to be cleaned.

One of the clutches has no adjustment. If after cleaning it still slips then burnishing will be required. Burnish the clutch wheel with some 250-grit sandpaper.

The other clutch has an adjusting nut that can be tightened if there is still slippage after cleaning.

I use QD Electronic Cleaner from Walmart (Auto parts and supplies section). See photo below.

If there is hardened grease the spray will not remove use alcohol. Brush on with small stiff brush then spray clean with QD.

Sometimes it is caked on, and I have seen some this way, and you cannot get it all off. In this case you may have to remove all the knobs and the front panel to get it clean. Then you can get to everything with a small brush.
